Broadcasting Radio Dramas:

The second Radio Drama broadcasting on 24th June 2021: WHMO's director and technical expert have to try to develop the planned dramas with edutainment-to not only educate but to also amuse the listeners and audience. These dramas highlight women's domestic duties and social responsibilities and their positive role in maintaining peace in the country by encouraging the community to support the peace-building process or negotiations.

Monitoring of program through WHMO Phone system: The programs are regularly heard with a keen interest in the target province which can be determined by their feedbacks-both positive negative. The programs are broadcasted on time following the weekly plan, the first and second radio drama broadcasted at 4:00 PM on Wednesday on 24th of June, following the Talk show Discussion which was broadcasted at 9:00 Am on Saturday on 19th of June too.
